- Learning opportunities



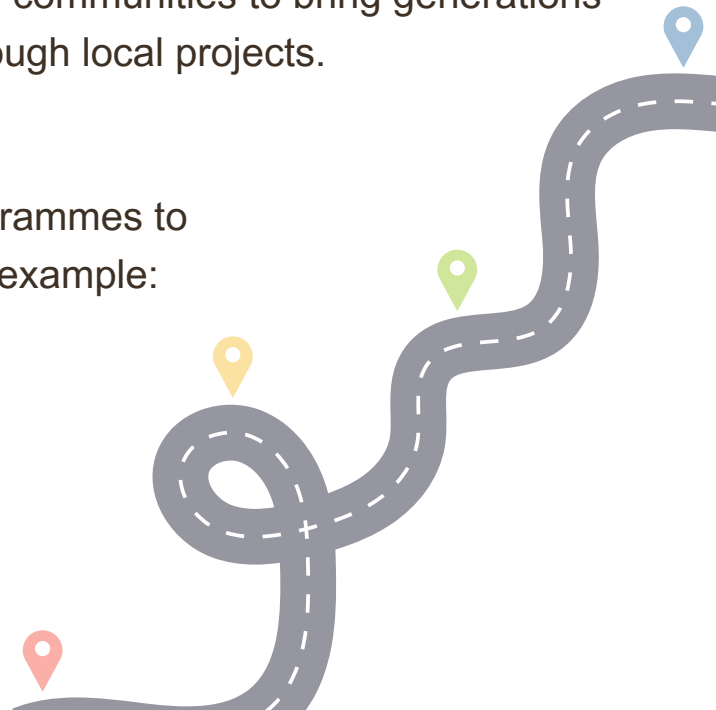
Generations Learning together
